

RADAR Licence, Terms and Conditions for Data Providers (Curators)

RADAR is an online service for the archival and publication of research data resulting from completed scientific studies and projects. RADAR is operated by FIZ Karlsruhe - Leibniz Institute for Information Infrastructure GmbH (hereinafter referred to as "we" or "us"). As a "Data Curator", you can use RADAR to compile research data into datasets, annotate these datasets with metadata, store them permanently and make them publicly available.

Licence

1. For the purposes of RADAR on the basis of your chosen license you grant us simple, temporally and spatially unlimited rights of use to the research data you have uploaded to the service. Your rights to the data are not thereby affected.
2. You will licence any transferred metadata with a CC0 licence and thus provide its free use by the general public.
3. You release us from third party claims that could be made against us as a result of any legal or rights infringements perpetrated by you.

User Instructions

1. You have received the role of data curator from the administrator (customer name). (Customer name), has granted you permission to use RADAR. As a data curator, you are entitled to upload research data into the RADAR repository.
2. When archiving or publishing a datasets, you must assign a license that governs usage rights in relation to possible reuse of the dataset. RADAR has included a list of appropriate licenses.
3. RADAR will be provided by us without cost.
4. We apply the technical and organisational approaches discussed in the service description to keep your data safe and reliably stored.
5. RADAR may only be used for activities related to the customer's business. Private use is not permitted.
6. You may not upload illegal content - for example, violent or offensive content in RADAR. The same applies to personal data without prior consent of the affected parties.
7. If we are made aware of violations of law relating to a dataset, we reserve the right to, without consulting you, block access to this dataset and, if necessary, delete the dataset.
8. You are responsible for the accuracy of the research data. Your personal data is used exclusively for the provision of the RADAR service. For further details please refer to the privacy policy.
9. Please be sure to observe the specifications of the RADAR service which are outlined in the service description. These clarify the features and purpose of RADAR, the tasks of the parties involved (Operators, Customers and Data Curators) as well as the related role descriptions.
