

RADAR Terms for Data Consumers

RADAR is an online service for the archival and publication of research data resulting from completed scientific studies and projects. RADAR is operated by FIZ Karlsruhe - Leibniz Institute for Information Infrastructure GmbH (hereinafter referred to as "we" or "us"). Using RADAR third parties ("data providers" / "data curators") may compile research data into datasets, annotate these datasets with metadata, store them permanently and make them publicly available. Review of the content and quality of the datasets is the sole responsibility of the data provider.

1. The relationship between you ("data consumer") and us exists solely in relation to the download of data packets or metadata. We reserve the right to restrict the use or terminate the provision of RADAR completely at any time.
2. If you are registered as a data consumer or are authorised by Shibboleth, the data provider may also grant you access to archived datasets.
3. You must comply with the conditions of the licence connected with the dataset used.
4. A full description of how we protect your personal data is explained in our privacy policy.
5. We assume no responsibility or liability for the accuracy, or reliability of the content or whether the content is up to date.
6. Access to RADAR as well as the ability to search and download datasets will be provided to you, the data consumer, without cost.
